DELHI UNIVERSITY (DU) Vice Chancellor Yogesh Singh Tuesday said St Stephen's College had not gotten back to the university after DU asked it to "rethink" its decision of hold-ing interviews for admissions to all categories of students for the cardemic session 2022-23

all categories of students for the academic session 2022-23. On Monday, Singh had told The Indian Express that Stephen's was insistent on holding inter-views, and that they had been told to reconsider.

He had said that a decision on the matter would be taken by the university once it received a response from stephen's.

We have not yet received a response from them. We had expected that they would send it by today, Maybe it will come by tomorrow. Once we receive the response. He Admissions Committee will hold a meeting and make the decision. On our end, our Academic Council has already made its decision that all colleges should hold undergradaute admissions only through CUET, the said.

Si Stephen's College is one of

the six minority colleges of DU. It reserves 50% seats for Christian candidates.

Contrary to DU's decision that admissions even to minority colleges will be held only through CUET scores, DU au-thorities had received a request from Stephen's to allow them to hold interviews across all cate-

nes. However, Singh had clarified However, Singh had clarified that the college had been com-municated that they should hold admissions to the general cate-gory seats only on the basis of the CUET score. For the remain-ing 50% reserved seats, they

However, in its admission However, in its admission policy released on its website, the college has said that "it reserves the right to proceed with admissions as per its own admission policy guaranteed to it as a minority institution and as a per past practice", and that it would, therefore, go ahead with the admissions based no 86% would, therefore, go ahead with the admissions based on 85% CUET score and 15% interview score "for all categories of applicants".

Day after 4-yr-old came under school van, family struggles to cope with the loss

"PAPA. MAIN theek hum, ghar jaana hai, thoda paami de do (Papa, la mfinel, lwa tuat tog) home, give me some water). As he sat on a bench at the mortuary on Tuesday morning. Gulshan Singh recalled his son's last words as he was undergoing treatment at a hospital on Monday. "He kept saying he is fine. On Monday, four-year-old Sidharth died after coming under his school's minibus (van) while being dropped off near his house in the village of

near his house in the village of Shikohpur. "Just two minutes of haste by the driver cost my son's life. What was the hurry?" said Singh. As his son's body was taken for post-mortem, he broke down twice. He pulled out his phone and scrolled through pictures of his son and showed them to a relative. Simb claimed that itself as

Singh claimed that just last week, his son had complained about the driver speeding while commuting to school. "I had thought of taking it up with the school authorities, but then school was closed for three days. I had enrolled him recently in LKG on April 5," said Singh. Relatives said that the fam-

ily has been in shock since the incident. "His mother has not eaten anything. He had just started going to school and was excited to learn new the started going to school and was excited to learn new the school and t things," said his grandfather, Rishal Singh. "Had an attendant or a

"Had an attendant or a conductor been present to help him get off the webide or if they had waited for a family member, my son would have been alive. The driver sped away immediately as he got down. 

Act notified, city to have one municipal corporation again

THE UNION Ministry of Law THE UNION Ministry of Law and Justice Tuesday notified the Delhi Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Act, 2022 to reunify the three municipal corporations in the capital According to the Act, the three civic bodies – Bast, South and North – will be merged and be called the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD).

All liabilities, employees, and revenue sources of the North, East and South MCDs

will soon be transferred to the unified body. The Centre will appoint a special officer to oversee the functions of the corporation.

The Union Cabinet cleared The Union Cabnet cleared the bill to merge the three MCDs on March 22, and passed it in Lok Sabha on March 30 amid protests from the Opposition. The Centre had cited increased financial liabil. ities of the three MCDs due to the trifurcation as the reason for the reunification of the MCDs, and Union Home Minister Amit Shah had ac-cused Delhi government of "step-motherly" treatment of the MCDs.
